

User Guidelines and Operation Instruction

Important Notes

- 1. Check that the circuit and socket meet the equipment's load and voltage requirements.
- 2. Set the temperature and time for the biological spectrum foot bath bucket based on individual circumstances and environmental conditions.
- 3. It is recommended to operate the product for 4 hours followed by a 1-hour downtime to effectively extend its lifespan.
- 4. When using the product, place a bath towel on the foot pedal.
- 5. After use, please turn off the instrument and unplug the power cord.

Operation Method

- 1. Plug the instrument into a dedicated three-port socket.
- 2. Press the power touch "Switch" key. The control panel will display 60 minutes and 30°C (86°F), allowing you to enter the setup interface. After 8 seconds, the current temperature measured in the bucket will be shown, with the countdown timer displaying 60 minutes.
- 3. To set the temperature, press the "Temperature" key to select a desired temperature within the range of 25°C to 65°C (77°F to 149°F). It is generally recommended to set the temperature to 55°C (131°F) for optimal results.
- 4. To set the time, press the "Time" key to select a desired duration within the range of 1 to 60 minutes. It is generally recommended to set the time to 60 minutes. When the countdown reaches "00," the instrument will stop working.
- 5. To stop the operation at any time, press the "Switch" key to turn off the power and unplug the device.
- 6. After use, always unplug the power supply.

Precautions and Maintenance

- 1. Do not allow individuals who are not self-sufficient, those unable to operate it independently, or infants to use the product.
- 2. If you feel uncomfortable or notice any abnormal sensations in your body or skin, stop using the product immediately.
- 3. For prolonged use, adjust the temperature appropriately to avoid low-temperature burns.
- 4. Do not sit or stand on the product.
- 5. Do not use or store the product in bathrooms or areas with high humidity.
- 6. Do not add water to the product or wash it with water.
- 7. When handling the product, use both hands to prevent slipping and potential damage.
- 8. Never put your head inside the product.
- 9. Do not use it under a quilt.

- 10. After use, cover the product with a bag to prevent dust accumulation, and store it in a dry place. Allow the bath towel to dry thoroughly after use.
- 11. The instrument should not be wiped with a wet cloth. Always turn off the power to avoid electric shock.

Woodbridge warrants its products as listed in below to be free of material and workmanship defect, subjected to the limitations set forth in this limited warranty.

- Bathtub, Whirlpool/Air Bubble Massage Tub, Wooden Cold Plunge: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Toilet and Bidet:1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Faucet:1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Vanity: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Granite, Marble, Engineered Quartz Vanity Top: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Medicine Cabinet, LED Mirror:1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Stainless Steel Sink: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Solid Surface Shower Wall Panel, Shower Base and Vanity Top: 10 Years limited warranty to be free from material defects.
- Shower Door: Lifetime warranty on glass components and 1Year limited on other hardware.

This limited warranty is non-transferable and only applies to products purchased and installed in the United States and Canada.

Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) from the original purchaser, Description and pictures of defect, model number or model description must be provided to Woodbridge Bath for all warranty claims and Woodbridge Bath IS NOT responsible for labor cost, removal or installation costs.
